Camping Rules 2021



We want everyone to have an enjoyable experience camping at the Bob Marshall Music Festival. For that reason, we have put some rules into place. If we all work together to make this the Bob etiquette, we'd be so thankful. Remember, we're all in this because we love friends, family, live music, and good times. Happy Bob!

- Generators can only be run from 8 am to 1 pm. Propane cooking is allowed.
- Please be respectful of our security team and comply with their requests.
- Camping check-in will begin on Thursday, August 5 at 3 pm. And, no earlier!
- Everyone in the camping area who is over the age of 12 will need to have a camping wristband. Four camping wristbands are included with every site. Additional wristbands can be purchased for \$20/person.
- No pets are allowed at the Bob Marshall Music Festival grounds. No emotional support animals.
- Because of dust at the camping area, we ask that those with electric bikes, ATVs, golf carts, and motorcycles not travel at excessive speeds or in continual loops. If you are asked to slow down, please comply.
- There are no open fires allowed.
- There is no group campfire in the campground.
- Quiet hours are 1 am to 8 am. Please no generators after 11 pm.
- Campsites are assigned when you reserve them and cannot be changed.
- Camping charges do include the 7% Montana lodging tax.
- Sites designated for tents can have a camper if that camper can easily fit within the 20 x 20 ft site.
- You can have two vehicles located on each site, provided they fit within your 20 x 20 area. Additional vehicles can be parked at overflow parking at no additional cost.
- This festival is in a gigantic field. Be respectful and go away from other people to smoke. And, don't forget THIS IS FIRE SEASON IN MONTANA. Dispose of cigarette butts in an appropriate receptacle.
- Showers are available 6.5 miles from the festival grounds at the Placid Lake State Park (5001 N Placid Lake Rd). Bring your quarters! Montana residents can enter the park for free. Non-residents will be charged \$8.
- RVers any gray or black water needs to be disposed of properly off-site. Don't let your gray water drain on the festival grounds. This will be strictly enforced.
- The festival provides porta-potties, handwashing stations, and trash cans.
- There are no RV hook-ups or power hook-ups.
- No Weapons. No Firearms. No Fireworks.
- Our security guys are wearing orange and our staff is wearing yellow. They don't want to have to give you a bad time so follow the rules.
- Reminder: there is no outside alcohol allowed into the music area. None. At. All.
