

2022 Bob Marshall Music Festival Camping Rules

We want everyone to have an enjoyable experience camping at the Bob Marshall Music Festival. For that reason, we have put some rules into place. We're all here because we love friends, family, live music, and good times. Happy Bob!

- Generators can be run from 8 am to 11 pm, unless the fire threat level changes during the festival.
- Propane cooking is allowed.
- There are no wood fires allowed. Propane fires are okay.
- Everyone in the camping area who is over the age of 12 will need to have a camping wristband. Four camping wristbands are included with every site. Additional wristbands can be purchased for \$20/person.
- No pets are allowed at the Bob Marshall Music Festival grounds. No emotional support animals.
- Because of dust at the camping area, we ask that those with electric bikes, ATVs, golf carts, and motorcycles not travel at excessive speeds or in continual loops. If you are asked to slow down, please comply.
- Quiet hours are 1 am to 8 am. Please no generators after 11 pm.
- You can have two vehicles parked on each site, provided they fit within your designated site. Additional vehicles can be parked at overflow parking with a donation of \$5 to the Silver Lining Foundation.
- This festival is in a gigantic field. Be respectful and go away from other people to smoke. **And, don't forget THIS IS FIRE SEASON IN MONTANA.** Dispose of cigarette butts in an appropriate receptacle.
- RVers - any gray or black water needs to be disposed of properly off-site. Don't let your gray water drain on the festival grounds. This is strictly enforced.
- No Weapons. No Firearms. No Fireworks.
- Our security crew is easily recognizable with their security shirts. They don't want to have to give you a bad time so please be nice.

ALSO: There are NO OUTSIDE BEVERAGES allowed into the music area. None. At. All.
